The Royal Greenwich Changemakers Challenge will run until the end of 2024!

It'll be about raising awareness of decision makers locally and also influencing a range of decision makers, from councillor, mayors, MPs and candidates

The challenge will cover the following points:

Understand - Network looking into research for candidates standing in their local constituency

Manifesto - will read the Scout manifesto, evaluate the points and look at how party policies align with the Scout manifesto

Advocate - Network will discuss with the 18-24 team on what can be improved for Network, the District and Local area

Represent - Network members will attend one of the District youth hustings and put their views as well as questions to Parliamentary candidates ahead of the general election.





Understand



To achieve this part of the award you'll need to complete all of the below activities

Research which candidates are standing in your constituency, or another local decision maker such as a Councillor, Mayor or Assembly Member. Know who they represent, what they stand for and evaluate how this compares to your own beliefs

Register to vote in the general election and all future elections



Make sure you have a valid voter ID or order a Voter ID Certificate
