Decision Makers

Parents: Mum and Dad make decisions about bedtime, meals, and family activities.

Teachers: They decide what to teach, what stories to read, and when it's time for playtime.

Doctor: Decides when you need a check-up or what medicine to take when you're poorly.

Police Officer: Helps keep everyone safe and decides what to do if there's an emergency.

Librarian: Decides which books to recommend and helps you find your favourite stories.

Mayor: The mayor makes decisions about the town or city, like building parks and organising community events.

Firefighter: Decides how to put out fires and helps people in emergencies.

Councillors: They help make decisions about local laws and improvements in the neighbourhood.

Park Ranger: Decides what activities are allowed in the park and helps keep it clean and safe.

Local Shop Owner: Decides what toys, books, or snacks to sell in their shop.

Lollipop Person: Decides when it's safe to cross the road and helps children get to school safely.

Local Farmer: Decides what fruits and vegetables to grow and bring to the local market.

Squirrel Leader: Decides on activities and adventures for the Squirrels (the youngest section of Scouts) and helps them learn and have fun.
